## Photography DIGITAL

### Project Criteria

- > Project must be original and 100% student work, i.e. photography and digital enhancement.
- > Digital effects, techniques and/or enhancements are permitted.
- > Electronic file criteria:
  - Size: the longest edge a minimum of 2240 pixels
  - Resolution: 300 dpi
  - Saved as a .jpg file

### Judging Criteria

- > Technical Technical Quality:
  - Proper exposure and contrast working together
  - Use of full tonal scale with proper exposure and contrast
  - Awareness given to the entire frame
  - Appropriately focused, clean and properly spotted
- > Artistic Merit:
  - Is the photograph clear in terms of subject?
  - Is the photograph effectively composed?
  - Does the photograph have visual impact?
  - Does the photograph elicit thoughtful or emotional reflection?
  - Has the idea/concept/theme been presented clearly?

Project LPIE is a project based competition in 13 categories that allow Acalanes High School students to showcase their skills.

Project LPIE is open to all Acalanes High School students. Projects may be created within or outside the classroom.

Awards given in every category.
