## Creative Writing

### Project Criteria

- > Write a short story, excerpt, or original creative writing piece. The piece should be typed, double spaced and be between 3 and 10 pages long.
- > Please be aware of your audience. Topic, tone and subject should be appropriate for a high school classroom.

### Judging Criteria

- > Quality of writing: Does the writer demonstrate a command of the language?
- > Development: Does the writer use purposeful details that deepen understanding?
- > Craft: Does the writer skillfully use story structure and/or literary devices?
- > Tone: Does the writer set a consistent tone or impact the reader emotionally?
