

With a well-rounded and comprehensive curriculum that includes social emotional learning and student wellness, our students are prepared for life after high school. Welcome!

WHAT IS LPIE?

LPIE is your local, nonprofit education foundation that supports our students every day by providing Lafayette public schools with impactful funding. In 1980, with our schools facing budget cuts due to Proposition 13, an invitation was sent to the community asking for “people who want to help.” From this, our education foundation was established to ensure continued educational excellence despite an uncertain funding environment. **Today, LPIE’s mission remains true: to support and enrich the education of every child in the Lafayette public schools.**



In 2020, LPIE celebrated its 40th anniversary. LPIE is a pillar in our community and a source of unwavering support for AHS. It is because of the generosity of parents, community members, and business partners that LPIE is able to provide millions of dollars in funding each year to our schools.

WHY DO WE NEED A FOUNDATION FOR PUBLIC SCHOOLS?

Public funding for schools in California is not sufficient to provide the excellence in education that we seek for our children. California schools are ranked 41st in the nation in per-student spending. Furthermore, Acalanes Union High School District is the lowest funded high school district in California due to the way the state allocates funds. Government funding and local taxes cover only 96% of the amount spent per student at Acalanes. The money raised by LPIE covers that additional 4% gap. Neighboring school districts including Orinda, Moraga, Piedmont, San Ramon, and Walnut Creek also benefit from community-supported foundations.

If you are new to California, it may seem unusual to rely on parent donations to help support our public schools, but **it is necessary to ensure our children receive a robust and well-rounded education.** If you look at most high-performing communities in California, they all have an education foundation.

HOW DOES YOUR CHILD BENEFIT FROM LPIE?

LPIE dollars fund every student, every day, in every grade. Your donations are put to work within the current school year to help maintain important people, programs, and supplies that help ensure a well-rounded education.

WHEN TO GIVE AND WHAT IS OUR GOAL?

LPIE is a 501c3 nonprofit organization and each year we start from \$0.00. The consistent participation from parents, community, and local businesses has allowed LPIE to raise more than \$3M annually for the past several years for our students and schools.

During registration in July, you will be invited to participate in LPIE's Annual Giving Campaign. Your donation will be spent during the current school year. There are two primary levels of giving:

- **Suggested donation: \$1,200 per Acalanes student**
- **Major Donor: \$5,000 or more per family**

Our goal is 100% participation by all Lafayette school district families.

Therefore, we encourage families to donate at a level that is meaningful to them. Every donation makes a difference.
