Video Production

Project Criteria

- > Project must be original work.
- > Posted online (YouTube, Vimeo, etc.) with a link to a URL.
- > Production must be appropriate for educational setting. The entry can be disqualified if this is not followed.
- > Project Submission Form must include a brief summary indicating theme, category selected, and identification of target audience. Projects may be completed by individuals or groups of up to 4 students.

**Actual video must include written credits including name(s) of students submitting the work. Any prize to be shared among students submitting.

- > Select one of the five following categories for participation:
 1. **PSA (Public Service Announcement):** Maximum of 60 seconds; all graphics, i.e. names, dates, titles, and credits must be included; and identify target audience.
 2. **Commercial:** Maximum of 60 seconds; feature the sale of any product, e.g. car, invention, etc.; and identify target audience.
 3. **Documentary / Presentation / Instructional:** Maximum 10 minutes; express any theme or program, e.g. seat belt safety and identify target audience.
 4. **Entertainment:** Maximum 10 minutes; express any area of entertainment, e.g. drama, comedy, mystery, adventure, animation; identify target audience.

Judging Criteria

- > Videos will be judged on theme and category selection identified, time requirements met, target reached, content of video, editing principals, smoothness of transitions, overall video quality, write-up, and originality.
