3D Fine Art/ Applied Design

Project Criteria

- > The 3D Applied Art/Design category includes functional projects or scaled models (architectural design and 3D modeling/printing) that exhibit craftsmanship or computer design utilizing 3-dimensional design principles.
- > Materials such as paper, wood, metal, plastic, ceramic, glass, leather, fabric, wire etc. may be used singly or in combination.
- > Size limitations: 75 pounds maximum. The project should not exceed 6' in any dimension, must fit through a 3 foot x 7 foot office door and must be transportable without needing special equipment or knowledge. Large and/or fragile projects will need to be transported to the judging site by the student or parent.
- > Student name must be printed on the back or underside of the project.

Judging Criteria

- > Craftsmanship & Skill
- > Originality
- > Basic Design Principles: good use of line, form, balance, surface texture, and proportion.
